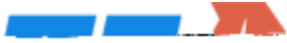


Course: Physical Theatre I

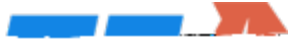
*Course description:*

Physical Theatre I, is the first level in a series courses designed to build physical communication for the theatre. Students will study body alignment, abstract movement, corporal mime, and specific Illusionary mime skills. Students will also study neutral and three dimensional mask work, and perform tertiary roles in a full-length silent theatre production. Students will explore each of these areas to develop the skills necessary to create and perform in-depth and nuanced non-verbal characters. These skills are vital in creating dynamic theatrical pieces giving students the tools to communicate three dimensional characters in complete stories. This course engages students in the development of physical character, physicalization of specific characteristics
