

This glossary explains how the following terms are used with respect to TELPAS Alternate.

Academic relates to ideas or language used on tests and assignments during instruction in reading, writing, science, and social studies. Examples of academic terms include, but are not limited to, analyze, compare, and conclude.

This term refers to the ways a student shows active engagement with a task and a presenter. Examples include, but are not limited to, eye gaze, head turn, vocalization, gestures, and changes in facial expression.

AAC refers to means other than traditional communication by which a student can share a spoken or written message with others. Examples include,
