The 2024 CCMR Tracker is released in stages

- x Part I March 29, 2024: CCMR outcomes reported through TSDS PEIMS, TSIA results, and OnRamps course completion through the 2022-23 school year, SAT, ACT, AP, IB and level I/II certificate results through the 2021-22 school year
- x Part II Summer 2024: CCMR outcomes for SAT, ACT, AP, IB, and level I/II certificates through the 2022-23 school year

Note, the CCMR Tracker contains lagging data as detailed on page 15. While the CCMR Tracker contains students who were in grades 9-12 on the 2023-24 PEIMS snapshot, it does not contain results from school year 2024 as those data have yet to be reported.
